In the early morning hours of May 1st, a massive fire ravaged St. William Catholic Church in Cashion, Arizona, (near Avondale, Az.). St. William church, (which serves 1,000 families), the parish hall, classrooms and food bank were destroyed beyond repair. The foodbank led by the Society of St. Vincent De Paul, served over 25 families in need on weekly basis.

While the official cause of the fire is still being determined. There is insurance, however, funds will still be needed to assist the staff and community in order to address the unknown expenses and those additional needs that will not be covered by the insurance.


