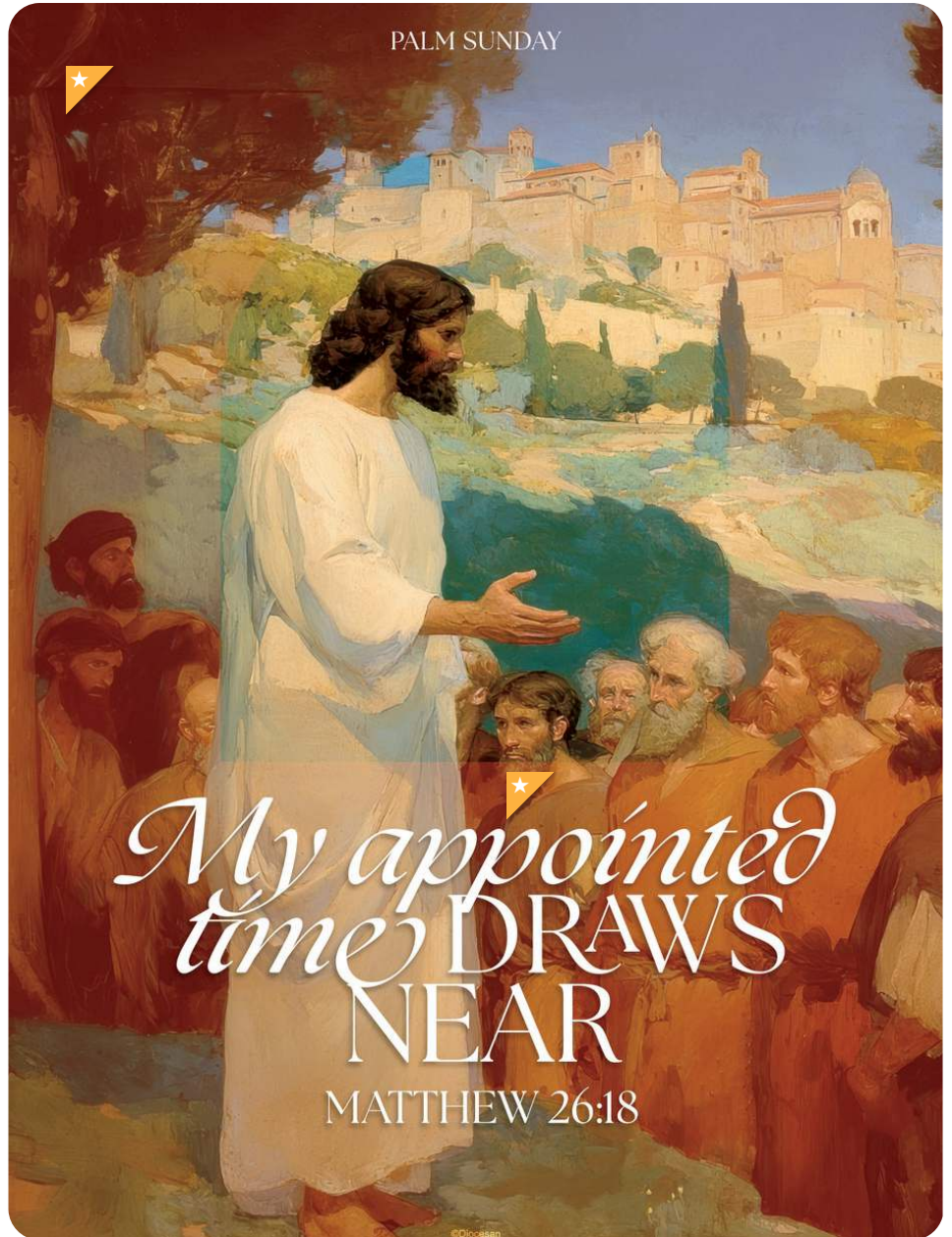

 Faith requires courage. Churches across the world face threats, and attacks on Christians continue to rise. Many believe danger stays far away, yet reality proves the opposite. Your parish requires men who stand watch.

The Porters of St. Joseph **protect the flock, watch entrances, respond during emergencies, assist during medical events, and guard the sacred space where families gather for Mass.**

Many men in our parish served with honor as soldiers, marines, airmen, sailors, police officers, and first responders. Your training and experience matter. Other men carry a strong duty to serve, to protect family, community, and Church. This ministry calls those men.

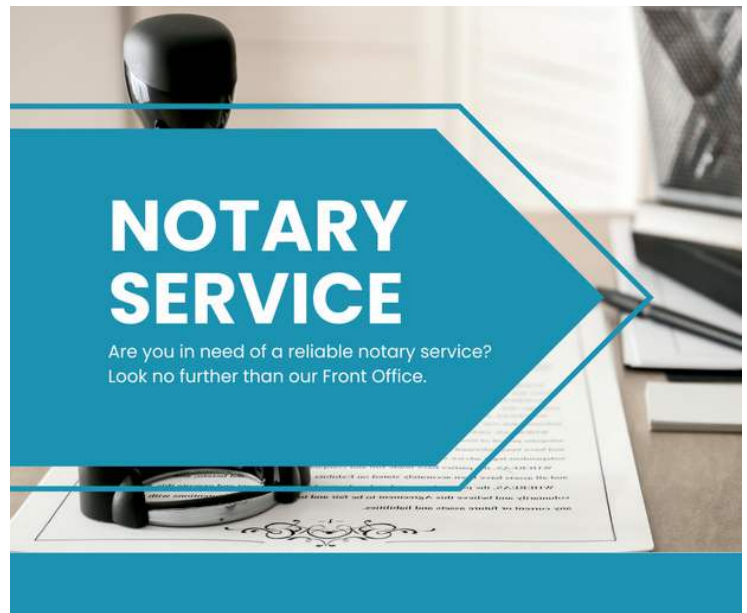
Service requires one hour during a weekend Mass. Remain alert and ready. Protect fellow parishioners. Training occurs each quarter and includes **safety response procedures, medical and CPR response, emergency coordination, and preparation for mass casualty events.**

When a parishioner collapses in a pew, the Porters respond. When a crisis occurs, the Porters stand ready. Saint Joseph guarded the Holy Family. Follow his example. Men of Christ, step forward and stand watch over your parish.

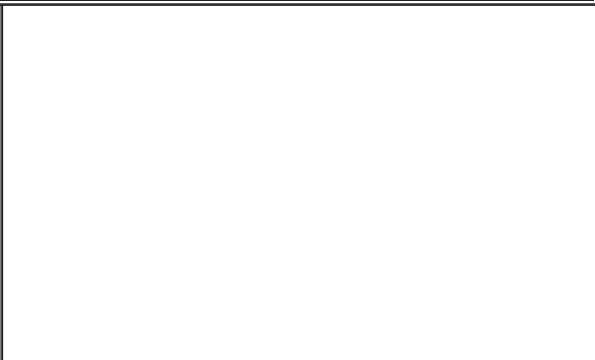

From Gratitude Flows Generosity

Faithful Stewardship in the Face of the Cross

“Take and eat; this is my body.”

“Drink from it, all of you,

for this is my blood of the covenant,

which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins.”

In the Passion, we witness both betrayal and extraordinary love. While Judas takes for himself and Peter falters in fear, Jesus gives Himself completely—body and blood—for our salvation. This Gospel reveals that true stewardship is not about self-preservation, but about self-gift rooted in trust in the Father’s will. Even in suffering, Jesus remains faithful, showing us that love is measured by sacrifice. As stewards, we are called to move beyond fear and respond with generosity, offering our lives in gratitude for the One who gave everything for us.

Petition:

That we may follow Christ’s example of self-giving love, remaining faithful in times of trial and generously offering our time, talents, and treasure in service to God and others, let us pray to the Lord.

Stewardship: Grace In Action

This week, reflect on how Christ has given everything for you, especially through the gift of the Eucharist. Consider where fear, hesitation, or self-interest may be holding you back from fully living as a steward. Is God inviting you to give more generously, forgive more freely, or trust Him more deeply in a difficult situation? Ask for the grace to respond with courage, and take one concrete step to live with sacrificial love.

As faithful stewards, may we imitate Christ by giving not only from our abundance, but from our very selves.

- Where in my life am I being called to move from fear or hesitation to trust and generosity?
- How does the Eucharist inspire me to give more fully of my time, talents, and treasure?
- What does sacrificial love look like in my daily life this week?
