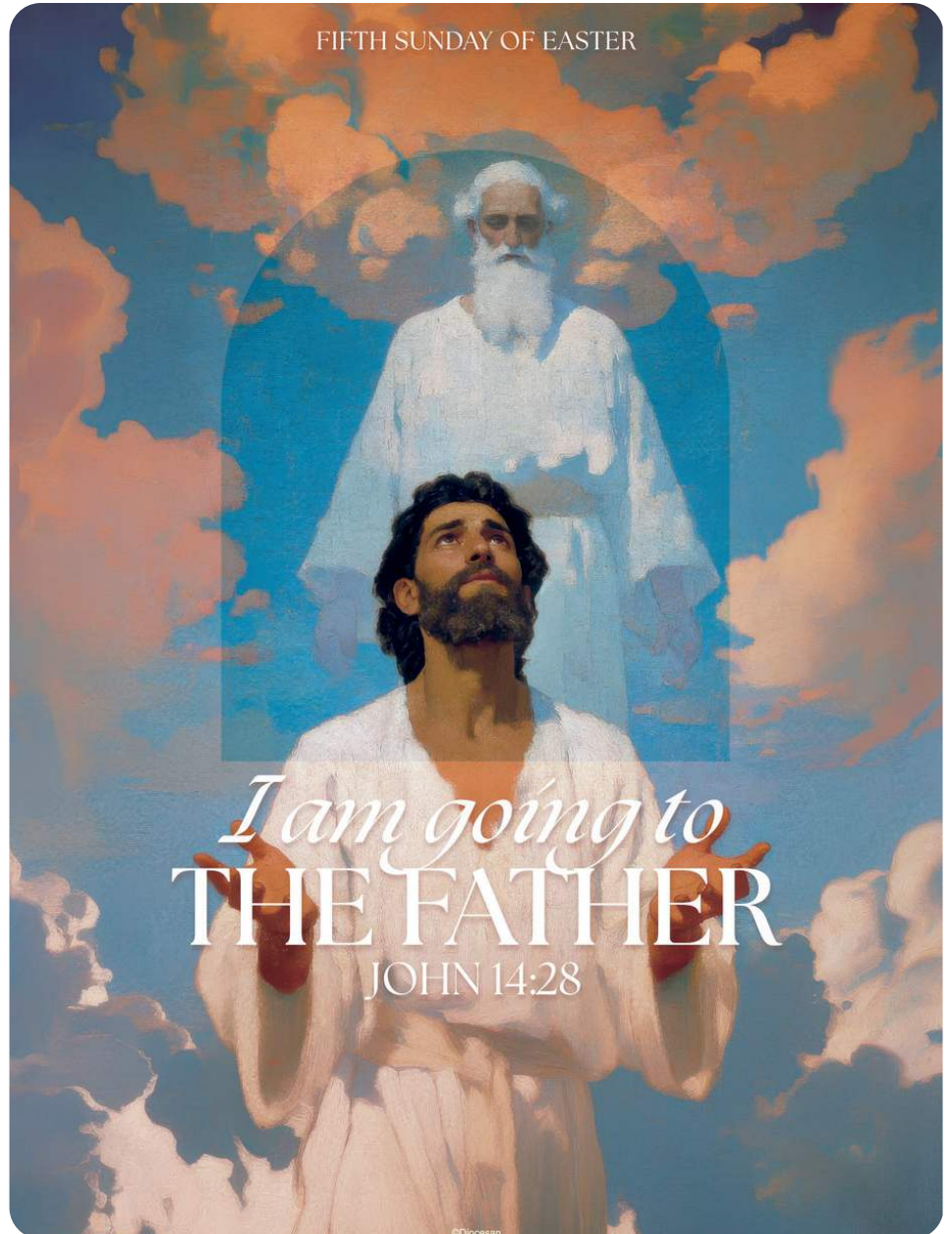

# MARY'S MONTH: WHY MAY BELONGS TO OUR LADY

## **May: The Month of Mary**

Every May, the Church dedicates the entire month to the Blessed Virgin Mary. This tradition dates to the 13th century and became widespread by the 18th and 19th centuries, when Catholics across Europe began holding special devotions, processions, and prayers in Mary's honor throughout the month.

## **Why Mary? And why May?**

May is a season of new life and beauty. The Church has long seen this as a fitting time to honor Mary, who said yes to God and made possible the salvation of the world. She is the mother of Jesus Christ, the first and greatest disciple, and the mother of the Church. Her role in salvation history is not decorative. She cooperated fully with God's plan, bore Christ into the world, stood at the foot of the Cross, and prayed with the apostles in the upper room at Pentecost.

Honoring Mary does not compete with honoring God. It points us to him. She leads us to her Son.

## **Our Lady of Fatima: May 13th**

On May 13, 1917, the Virgin Mary appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal. Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta received a series of apparitions over six months. Mary called the world to prayer, penance, and consecration to her Immaculate Heart. The Church approved these apparitions, and May 13th is now a feast day on the Catholic calendar. This year, take a moment on that day to pray a rosary in her honor and reflect on her message: repentance, prayer, and trust in God's mercy.

## **The May Crowning**

One of the most beloved traditions of this month is the May Crowning. A statue or image of Mary is crowned with a wreath of flowers, usually by a young person from the parish, in the presence of the congregation. This simple act carries deep meaning.

We crown Mary as Queen, not because she sought power, but because her Son is King. The crown of flowers reflects her purity, her closeness to God, and the beauty of her role in salvation. It is an act of love and gratitude from the community to a mother who continues to intercede for us.

This month, pray the rosary. Attend the May Crowning. Mark May 13th on your calendar. Let Mary lead you closer to Christ.

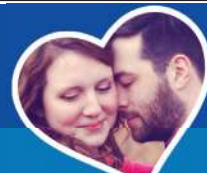

### Porters of St. Joseph: A new ministry at Our Lady of Lourdes.

Faith requires courage. Churches across the world face threats, and attacks on Christians continue to rise. Many believe danger stays far away, yet reality proves the opposite. Your parish requires men who stand watch.

The Porters of St. Joseph **protect the flock, watch entrances, respond during emergencies, assist during medical events, and guard the sacred space where families gather for Mass.**

Many men in our parish served with honor as soldiers, marines, airmen, sailors, police officers, and first responders. Your training and experience matter. Other men carry a strong duty to serve, to protect family, community, and Church. This ministry calls those men.

Service requires one hour during a weekend Mass. Remain alert and ready. Protect fellow parishioners. Training occurs each quarter and includes **safety response procedures, medical and CPR response, emergency coordination, and preparation for mass casualty events.**

When a parishioner collapses in a pew, the Porters respond. When a crisis occurs, the Porters stand ready. Saint Joseph guarded the Holy Family. Follow his example. Men of Christ, step forward and stand watch over your parish.

As faithful stewards, may we walk confidently in the way of Christ and share His truth and life with others.

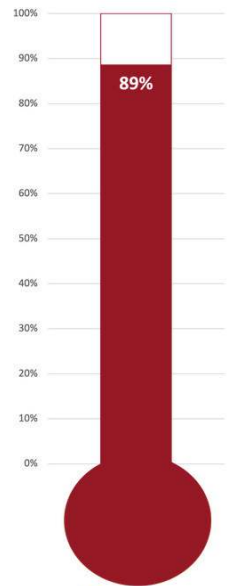

We are grateful to share that, since our February 7–8 kickoff, our parish has raised **\$119,038** toward our Catholic Development Appeal goal of \$134,399—reaching **89%**!
