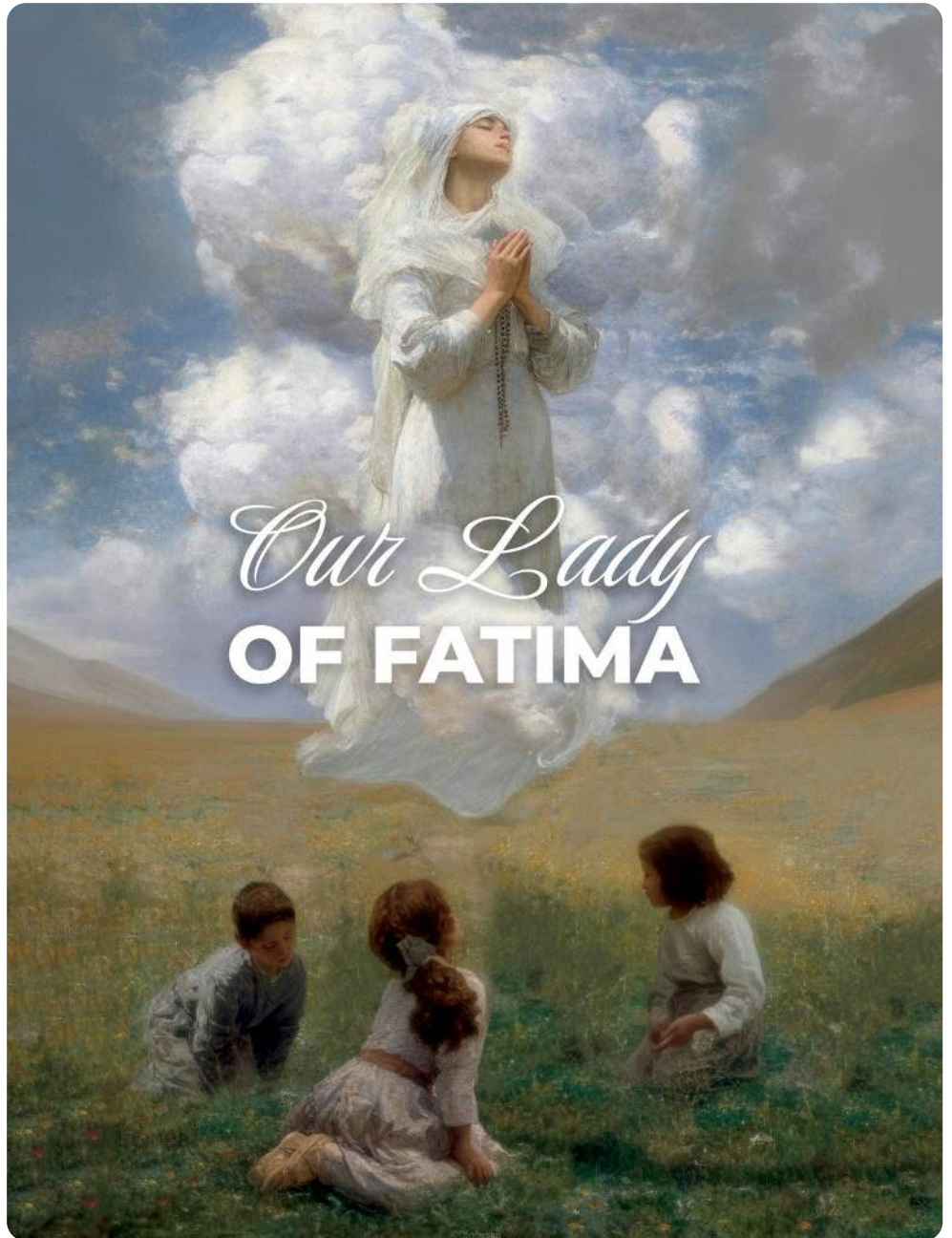

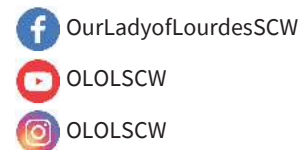

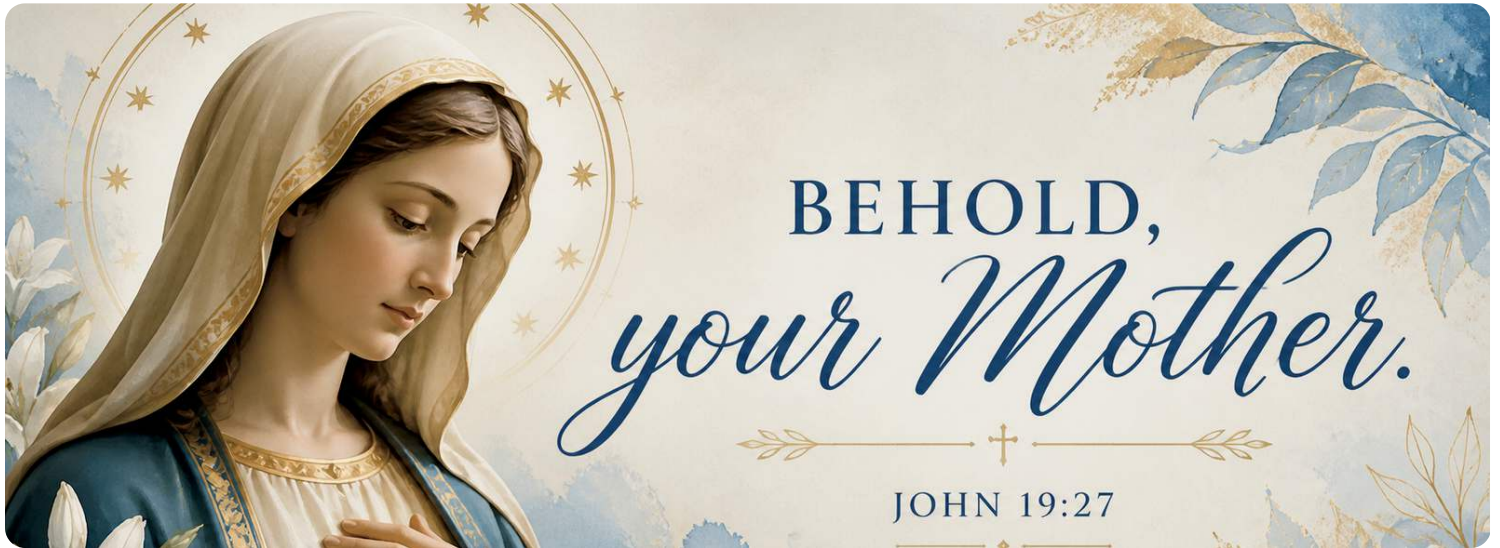

BEHOLD, YOUR MOTHER

Happy Mother's Day

This Sunday, we pause to honor the women who shape our lives through love, sacrifice, and faith. Mothers are not accidents of biology. They are part of God's design. Every mother in this parish reflects something real and true about who God is.

God Is Love. Mothers Show Us What That Looks Like.

God gave us mothers so we would have a living picture of unconditional love. When a mother sits up through the night with a sick child, when she forgives without being asked, when she shows up again and again regardless of the cost to herself, she is reflecting God's love back to us. That is a sacred calling.

Mary: Mother of Us All

The Church has always looked to Mary as the model of motherhood. She said yes to God without knowing the full weight of what she agreed to. She carried Christ, raised Him, followed Him to the cross, and stood there when others fled. At Calvary, Jesus looked down at John and said, "Behold, your mother" (John 19:27). The Church understands those words as a gift to all of us. Mary is not a distant figure. She is a mother who intercedes, who watches, and who cares.

Pope Saint Paul VI formally declared Mary "Mother of the Church" in 1964, giving a title to what Catholics had believed for centuries. She is the mother of the Body of Christ, which is us.

Honoring Every Kind of Mother

Motherhood takes more than one form. Today we also honor godmothers, who made promises at the baptismal font and took on real spiritual responsibility for a child's faith. Religious sisters, who gave their lives to God and have mothered countless souls through service, prayer, and presence. Women who mentor, who saw someone who needed guidance and chose to show up for them. You do not have to give birth to mother someone. The Church has always known this.

To Those Who Are Hurting Today

Mother's Day is not easy for everyone. Some women carry the quiet grief of infertility. Some carry the loss of a child. Some sit in this pew missing their own mother. You are seen. Your grief is real. The Church holds space for you today, not with easy answers, but with presence and prayer.

To the Mothers We Have Lost

We remember the mothers who are no longer with us. Their voices shaped us. Their prayers followed us. Their love left a mark that time does not erase. We commend them to God, who loved them before we did, and we trust they are held in that love now.

A Final Word

God blessed us with mothers so that we would have a glimpse of what His love for His children feels like. Every act of maternal love points to a God who does not abandon, does not forget, and does not stop loving.

"And a sword will pierce your own soul too." (Luke 2:35)

Mary knew love and suffering together. So do many of you. That is not a contradiction. In God's hands, it is the fullness of what it means to love.

To every mother in this parish, happy Mother's Day. Thank you for showing us what God's unconditional love looks like.

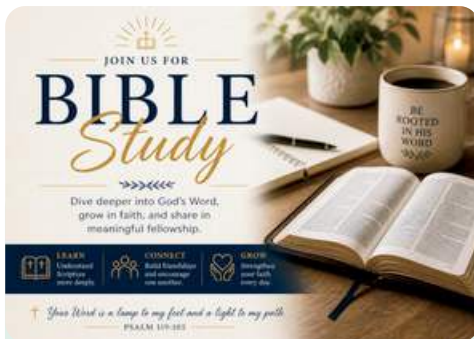

- How can I better rely on the Holy Spirit to guide my stewardship?

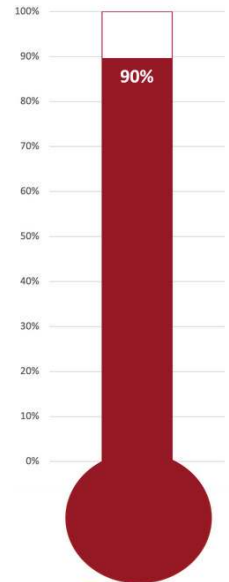

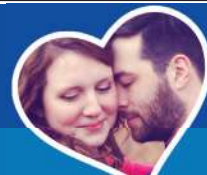


